


# Jelly Roll Check Quilt Pattern

Shortcut Quilt



Finished Size: 60 1/2" x 72 1/2"

## Fabric Requirements

- Two Merrily Jelly Rolls® or seventy-five 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips (Fabric A)
- 1 1/8 yards background fabric (48213-12)
- 1 1/8 yards accent fabric (48213-23)
- 3/4 yard binding (48214-23)
- 4 yards backing (48212-15)

## Cutting

- Cut background fabric into:
  - 30 - 6 1/2" squares (Fabric B)
- Cut accent fabric into:
  - 30 - 6 1/2" squares (Fabric C)
- Cut binding fabric into:
  - 8 - 2 1/2" x width of fabric strips (Fabric D)
- Notions:
  - Creative Grids 6 1/2" Quilting Ruler #CGR6

## Piecing Instructions

Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.



Divide your Fabric A strips into forty-five dark strips (A1) and thirty light strips (A2).

## Check Block

Assemble three dark Fabric A1 strips and two light Fabric A2 strips, alternating dark and light.

Check Strip Set should measure 10 1/2" x 42".

Make fifteen.


Folding the Check Strip in half lengthwise, finger press a crease in the center of the Check Strip Set.

Using the Creative Grids 6 1/2" Quilting Ruler, align the center of the ruler with the crease.

Subcut each Check Strip Set into four Check Blocks.

Check Block should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".

Make sixty.


Shortcut Quilt

## Check Rows

Assemble five Check Blocks and five Fabric B squares.

Background Check Row should measure 6 1/2" x 60 1/2".

Make six.



Make six.

Assemble five Fabric C squares and five Check Blocks.

Accent Check Row should measure 6 1/2" x 60 1/2".

Make six.




Make six.

## Quilt Center

Assemble the Quilt Center.

Quilt Center should measure 60 1/2" x 72 1/2".



## Finishing

Piece the Fabric D strips end to end for binding.

Quilt and bind as desired.
